Did you know...?

At the request of the DTS community, we have added the DTS Message Center. The Message Center enables a manager to easily communicate important messages such as counterfeit warnings, armored carrier issues, weather delays, and holiday reminders to their cash room staff. All messages can be targeted to specific groups of people and areas of the country. The Message Center is often more effective at delivering messages than other methods because often employees don't have individual email accounts or don't check them frequently. With the Message Center they must acknowledge that they've read a message before they can complete their deposits, change orders, or supply orders.

It's one more way that DTS helps companies manage their cash rooms more effectively.
